Why don't Councils/Officers submit reports?

"We're not looking for awards and recognition, so we don't bother"

"I didn't get around to submit the form".

"I thought the District Deputy does that".

"I'm not that great with the computer".

Officers not aware of responsibilities.

Importance of Reporting

Required as a Knights of Columbus Council, and the duties of an officer.

Communicating information on Council membership, leadership, and activities.

Ensuring that Councils remain in good standing.

Assessing needs for Council assistance.

Monitoring ongoing Council compliance.

Form 185-Report of Officers

Due date of June 30.

Important to ensure that all information is accurate so that communications can be confidently delivered to Council leadership. Form 365-Service Program Personnel Report

Form 944 – District Deputy Annual Report

Form to be completed by the District Deputy.

Form evaluates the Councils within your District.

Due date September 15 – This is a FIRM DEADLINE: forms will not be accepted after September 15.

Annual Survey of Fraternal Activities

Due January 31

Activities for calendar year period of January 1-December 31.

Covers Faith, Family, Community, and Life activies, as well as meetings and other fraternal commitments.

SP-7 Columbian Award Application

Due by June 30

Do not wait until due date to submit. Errors or incomplete forms can be corrected and resubmitted.

Aim to submit by June 1 or earlier.

Be descriptive and specific.

Form 11077-Fraternal Benefit Event Council Report Submitted by <u>Council</u> within 7 days of Fraternal Benefit Event (FBE).

Total of 10 attendees with roster of 99 or fewer.

Total of 14 attendees with roster of 100 or more.

Star Council Award

Council must earn Father McGivney (Membership), Founder's (Insurance/Fraternal Benefit), and Columbian (Program) Awards. Must also submit the Annual Survey of Fraternal Activities (1728), Report of Officers (185), and Service Program Personnel Report (365).

Must be Safe Environment compliant.

- Who must be Safe Environment Trained?
- Grand Knight trained
- Program Director trained
- Family Director trained and background check*
- Community Director trained and background check*
- *Background check is limited to State/Provincial sex offender registry, criminal, and motor vehicle databases <u>only</u> (no credit checks).

Safe Environment Program

- Certification term of 3 years.
- Be mindful of certification expiration dates.
- Training is done through a partnership with Praesidium. You will receive an email from them to access training requirements.
- At least one Knight that is Safe Environment certified must be present at a youth activity.
